### **Works Information and Notification letter: A413 Sustainable Travel Scheme**

Transport for Buckinghamshire will be constructing a cycle way route from Buckingham to Winslow. The scheme will introduce a safe 9km shared cycleway that interconnects Buckingham, planned East-West Winslow rail station and Winslow town centre.

The scheme aims to encourage sustainable travel (bus, cycle, walking) along the A413 corridor and connections to the planned East-West Winslow rail station and other local destinations in the area.

The scheme is funded from the government's Local Growth Fund, through the Buckinghamshire Thames Valley Local Enterprise Partnership.

The following footway work is due to commence shortly as follows.

- London Road, Buckingham. From Total Garage to Needlepin Way are scheduled to commence on the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2016 and it is estimated that they will take 7 days to complete.
- Winslow Road, Padbury. From Folly Inn to Thornborough turn are scheduled to commence on the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2016 and it is estimated that they will take 54 days to complete.
- Buckingham Road, Winslow. From Furze Lane to Hanover Farm are scheduled to commence on the 13<sup>th</sup> July 2016 and it is estimated that they will take 35 days to complete.

The duration of work for the whole 9km cycleway from Buckingham to Winslow is approximately 5 months. Information signs will be erected on site prior to commencement of the works at various sections along the A413 cycle way route, giving actual dates and durations. If for any



reasons the works are delayed, the advance information signs on site will be updated to reflect any change in dates.

Temporary traffic lights will be used during normal working hours and we would respectfully request that whilst works are being undertaken that vehicles are not parked on the highway and/or footway, as this would obviously cause an obstruction and prevent the necessary works from being carried out.
